## RESOLUTION REQUESTING ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF WATER MILL COURT FROM THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE MAINTAINED SECONDARY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, as authorized by N.C.G.S. 136-63, the attached petition, by the only affected property owners, has been filed with the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners requesting that a 125 foot portion of State Road 4600, a portion of Water Mill Court, the location of which has been indicated on the attached map, be abandoned from the North Carolina State Maintained Secondary Road System; and

WHEREAS, the City/County Planning Staff has reviewed the petition requesting abandonment and finds that no property owner would be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and egress to his/her property, the petitioners own all of the adjacent property, and there would be no negative impacts from maintenance being abandoned on the 125 foot portion of State Road 4600, a portion of Water Mill Court; and the Planning Staff therefore recommends in favor of the petition to abandon the said portion of road; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the City/County Planning staff, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners finds that the abandonment would serve the best interest of the people of Forsyth County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby requests the Board of Transportation, to review the proposed abandonment of the above described portion of road, and if in its opinion the public interest demands it, to abandon the said identified portion of the road from the State Maintained Secondary Road System.
