**RESOLUTION NAMING A STUDY ROOM AT THE KERNERSVILLE BRANCH  
LIBRARY IN MEMORY OF THEODORE C. AND BETTY LOU KERNER IN  
RECOGNITION OF A DONATION FROM THEIR DAUGHTER, SUSAN E. KERNER

**WHEREAS**, Theodore C. Kerner was born in 1917 and was a direct descendant of Joseph Kerner, the founder of Kernersville; and

**WHEREAS**, Theodore C. Kerner married the former Betty Lou Williams and the couple were lifelong residents of Kernersville; and

**WHEREAS**, Theodore and Betty Lou Kerner were devoted to community service with Theodore serving as a former chair of the Kernersville Zoning Board of Adjustment, director of First Union National Bank, member of the Kernersville Shepherd's Center Advisory Council, member of the Kernersville Little Theatre Advisory Board, director of the Kernersville Moravian Church band and treasurer of Korner's Folly, and with Betty Lou serving as member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Kernersville Historical Society and Friends of the Kernersville Branch Library; and

**WHEREAS**, both Theodore and Betty Lou Kerner shared a love of books, and their daughter, Susan E. Kerner, has donated \$10,000 in memory of her parents to support the Kernersville Branch Library construction project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Study Room #2 at the Kernersville Branch Library is hereby named as a memorial to Theodore C. and Betty Lou Kerner and in recognition of the donation of Susan E. Kerner.
